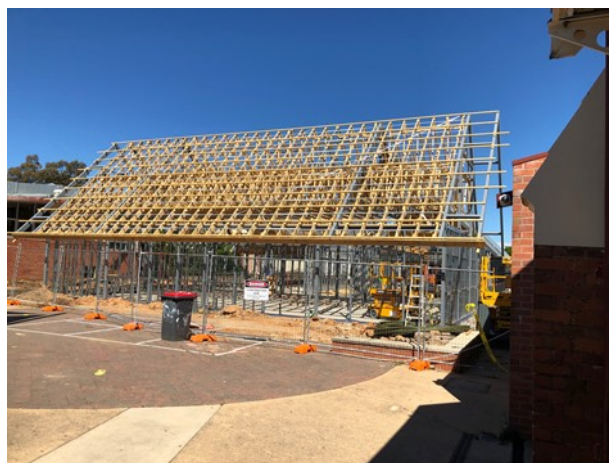
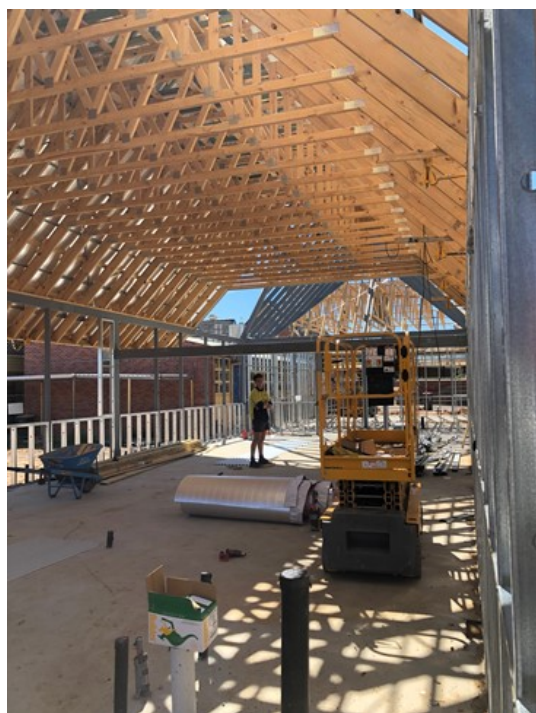


## Principal's Report

### New buildings

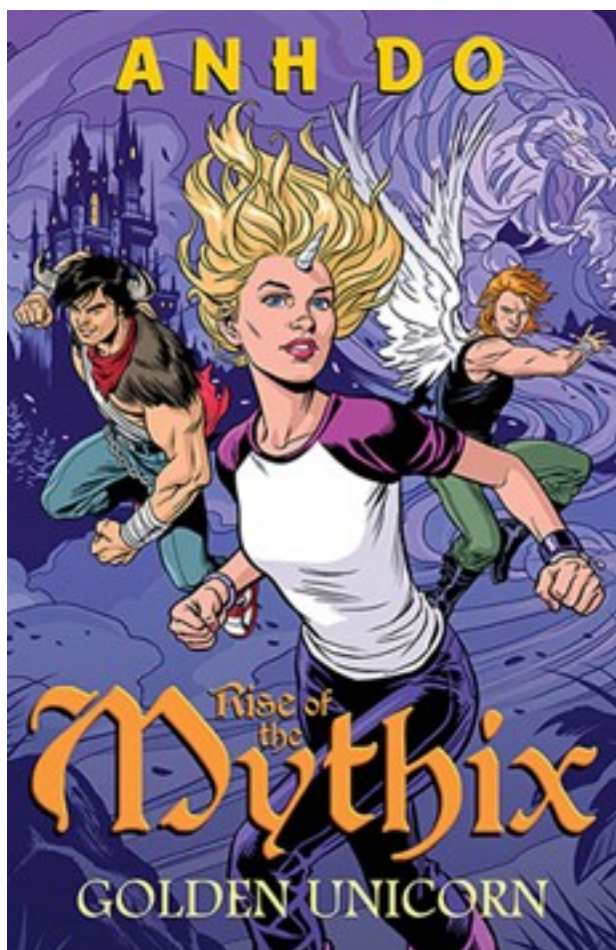

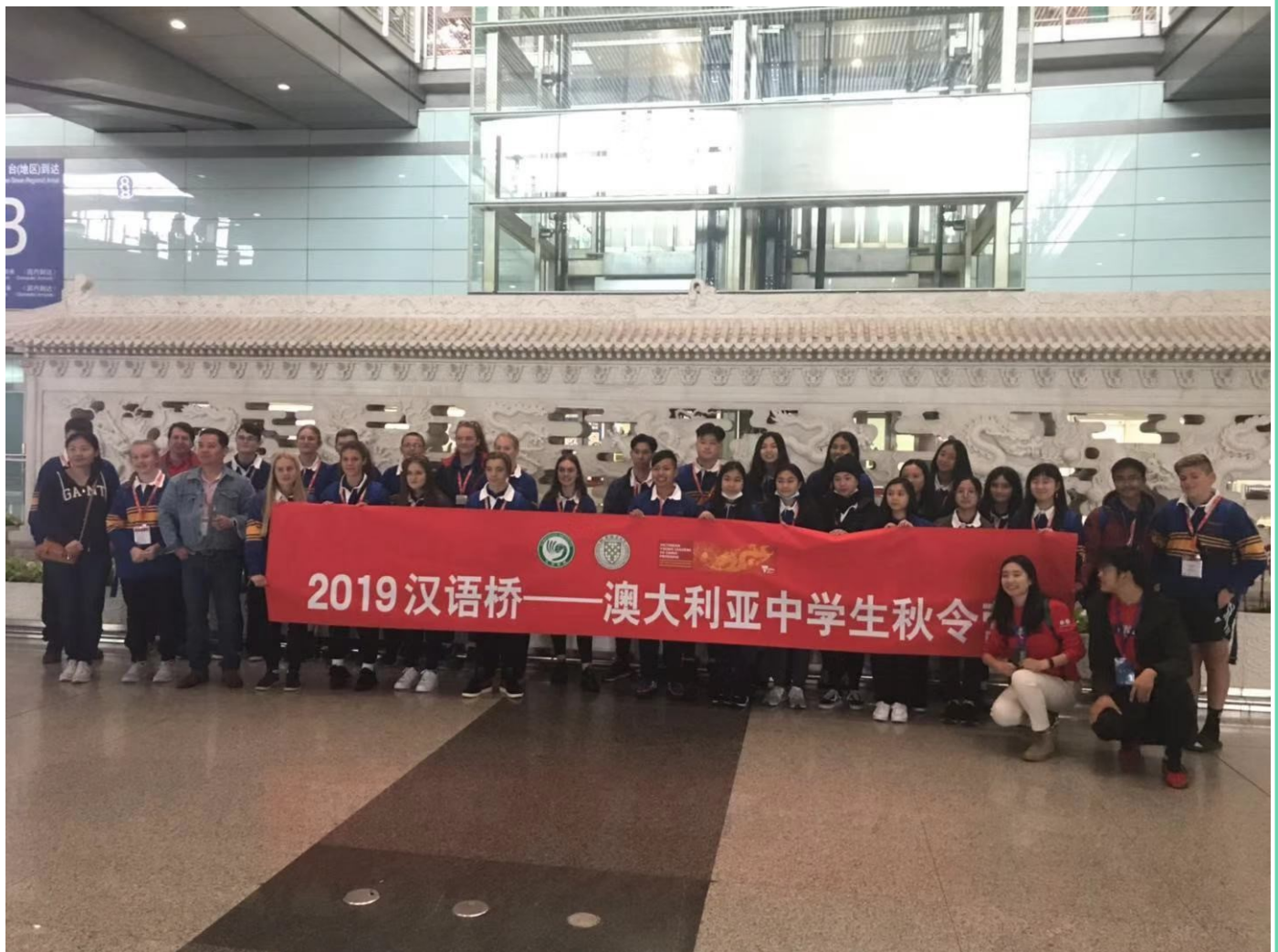


## Young Leaders To China
